### End of Key Stage Data July 2019

#### Early Years Foundation Stage

55.5% of children achieved a good level of development in Reception (2019 National Average 72%)

#### Year 1 Phonic Screen

80% of children passed their phonics screening check in Year 1. (2019 National Average 82%)

#### Key Stage 1

In Year 2 (25 children)

54.2% of children achieved the expected standard in reading (2019 National Average 75%)

8.3% of children achieved greater depth in reading (2019 National Average 15%)

37.5% of children achieved the expected standard in writing. (2019 National Average 69%)

0% of children achieved greater depth in writing (2019 national average 16%)

41.7% of children achieved the expected standard in maths. (2019 National Average 76%)

8.3% of children achieved greater depth in maths (2019 National Average 22%)

#### Key Stage 2

59% of children achieved the expected standard in reading. (2019 National Average = 73%)

25% of children achieved a high standard in reading. (2019 National Average = 27%)

72% achieved the expected standard in writing. (2019 National Average = 79%)

13% of children working in greater depth within the expected standard in writing. (2019 National Average = 20%)

75% achieved the expected standard in maths. (2019 National Average = 79%)

9% of children achieved a high standard in maths. (2019 National Average = 27%)

75% achieved the expected standard in Grammar Punctuation and Spelling (GPS). (2019 National Average = 78%)

31% of children achieved a high standard in GPS . (2019 National Average = 36%)

#### Average Scaled Score per Pupil in 2019

Average scaled score in reading = 103 (National Average 2019 = 104)

Average scaled score in GPS = 105 (National Average 2019 = 106)

Average scaled score in maths = 103 (National Average 2019 = 105)

#### Progress measures in 2019

Reading 2.8 Above Average

Writing 1.5 Average

Maths 0.8 Average

56% of children achieved the expected standard in reading, writing and maths combined at KS2 (in 2019 the National Average was 66%)

3% of children achieved the higher standard in reading, writing and maths combined at KS2 (in 2019 the National Average was 11%)
